Lust: a consuming desire that is either out of God's bounds or out of godly balance...

Do not lust in your heart after her beauty or let her captivate you with her eyes... (Prov. 6:25)

...how I have been grieved by their adulterous hearts, which have turned away from me, and by their eyes, which have lusted after their idols. (Ezek. 6:9)

The dark side of lust includes...

- Replacing God with lifeless counterfeits "They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator who is forever praised. Amen. Because of this, God gave them over to shameful lusts." (Rom. 1:25-26a)
- A quiet force of deadly <u>excess</u> "Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more." (Eph. 4:19)

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! (1 Cor. 10:12)

Going Grit: spiritual stamina to radically pursue holiness...

But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it out and throw it away.

(Matt. 5:28-29a)

- Walk by the Spirit "So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature." (Gal. 5:16)
- Run with caution...

The Biblical "running" strategy...

- Run from "Flee the evil desires of youth..." (2 Tim. 2:22a)
- Run to "...and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace..." (2 Tim. 2:22a)
- Run with "...along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart." (2 Tim. 2:22b)
- <u>Love</u> to honor "Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves." (Rom. 12:9-10)

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. (Matt. 5:8)
